*A Reading from the Gospels

Then one of them, when he saw that he was healed, turned back, praising God with a loud voice. He prostrated himself at Jesus' feet and thanked him. And he was a Samaritan. Then he said to him, "Get up and go on your way; your faith has made you well."
