Dear Prayer Partners,

Greetings in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, who died on the cross and rose again for our redemption. I trust this brief e-mail finds you in good health. Agnes and I together with our family are grateful to God for his goodness and faithfulness. The purpose of this email is to request for your prayers. This week has been difficult because of the problem of water not being pumped to the storage tanks. Thus, we have not been able to provide the much needed commodity to people in our community.

The technicians from the organization with whom we have a contract spent most of today trying to unearth the problem. They discovered that the company which drilled the well several years ago installed the casing halfway rather than all the way to the bottom. For that reason, the pump is not well supported, which makes it keep on tilting, which has made some of the cables to have scratches, caused by improper placement of the casing. This phenomenon may also damage the mortar.

The team has just finished removing all the pipes. We will get a full report on Monday April 4th, 2022 in order to know how much the new casing, damaged pipes, cables etc. The good news, however, is that there is a good amount of water at the well. Please pray with us that God will provide the funds needed to cater for this great need. God bless you.

In the first 8 months of our fiscal year 2021-22, LCCM has served just as many households as we did in all of 2020-21. The reason for the increase this year is because a lot of government assistance provided during the pandemic has ended.

So far, LCCM has served 788 households in our pantry—that breaks down to 734 children, 1,144 adults and 168 people over the age of 60.

Volunteer at HersheyPark

Are you interested in being a HersheyPark volunteer for our church?

For each shift you work (usually 3 to 5 hours long), you get a 1 day pass, including free parking, to HersheyPark. Occasionally, 2 or 3 passes are offered for a shift. This is great to use for yourself or to give to family members.
